

1. InesLegal B.V. is private limited liability company ("*besloten vennootschap*"). InesLegal B.V. is registered at the Commercial Register of the Dutch Chamber of Commerce in The Hague under registration number 66358728.
2. InesLegal B.V. regards all instructions as having been given to it exclusively, even if it is agreed that an instruction will be performed by a specific person affiliated with InesLegal B.V. The scope of Sections 404 and 407 (2), Book 7 of the Dutch Civil Code is excluded. The term 'affiliated person' includes InesLegal B.V.'s employees, advisors, partners and shareholders.
3. Any liability of InesLegal B.V. is limited to the amount that is paid out under its professional indemnity policy, plus the applicable excess.
4. Any liability of InesLegal B.V. for injury, loss or damage to persons or property is limited to the amount that is paid out under its liability insurance, plus the applicable excess.
5. Any claim for compensation will prescribe one year after the start of the day following that on which the client became aware of the injury, loss or damage and InesLegal B.V. being the liable party.
6. If InesLegal B.V. hires an unaffiliated person for the performance of the instruction, it will not be liable for an error that is made by this person. By giving an instruction to InesLegal B.V., the client grants InesLegal B.V. the authority to accept limitation of liability by unaffiliated persons on the client's behalf.
7. InesLegal B.V., any person currently or previously affiliated with InesLegal B.V. or a legal successor by universal title may rely on these general terms and conditions.
8. All services will in principle be charged to the client on a monthly basis, with a payment term of 14 days to be calculated from the date of the invoice. If timely payment is not met, InesLegal B.V. is entitled to charge statutory interest.
9. Dutch law applies to the legal relationship between InesLegal B.V. and its client. The courts in The Hague have exclusive jurisdiction to hear a dispute between InesLegal B.V. and a client.
10. There is a Dutch version and an English version of these general terms and conditions. In case of any inconsistency between these two versions, the Dutch version will prevail.
